- 1 These accounts are prepared on a Receipts and Payments basis and include gift aid received after 31 December 2010 relating to donations made before that date but not gift aid of £2,475 due on some donations received during the period 1 January 2011 to 31 December 2011 but receivable after 31 December 2011.
- 2 From 1 January 2012 the separate tertiary and secondary education bursary funds are being merged with the General Fund in order to simplify administration and increase flexibility in allocating funds.
- 3 The grants made to the Chole Social Development Society / Harambee Committee during the year included approximately £7,400 on account of expenditure budgeted for 2012.
- 4 A major donor to the Kindergarten Fund has agreed that if the Kindergarten is fully funded then any surplus funds (up to the limit of that donor's donation) may be transferred to the General Fund. No such transfer occurred during 2011.
- 5 The Capital Fund represents funds raised by a sponsor and grants received to fund IT equipment in the Chole Learning Centre. It was fully committed during
- 6 The amounts shown above include £1,323.63 transferred from The Tribes Foundation, which prior to the establishment of the Trust supported the Chole Project. No further amounts are due from The Tribes Foundation.
